

CLID. Italian Language Courses at Distance

Our CLID courses are organized into a blended learning format: 90 hours of live lessons on Zoom Pro Education and 30 hours of self-study through the MOODLE platform. We offer levels ranging from A1 to B2, according to the CEFR standards.

Course structure

- 90 hours of videoconference lessons (Zoom): 3 weekly lessons lasting 2h30' each (hours are 50 minutes)
- 30 hours on the Moodle platform with teacher tutoring
- Intermediate tests and final test

Attendance is mandatory for both live Zoom sessions and self-paced Moodle modules.

The lessons are held in the afternoon, on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday approximately from 4.30pm or 5.30pm until 7-8pm (Italian time).
